Requirements for Eagle Scout

5. While a Life Scout, plan, develop, and give leadership to others in a service project helpful to any religious institution, any school, or your community. (The project should benefit an organization other than Boy Scouting.) The project plan must be approved by the organization benefiting from the effort, your Scoutmaster and troop committee and the council or district before you start. You must use the Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project Workbook, BSA publication No. 18-927E, in meeting this requirement.

The Project Requirement

5. While a Life Scout, ***PLAN, DEVELOP,*** and ***GIVE LEADERSHIP*** to others in a service project helpful to any religious institution, any school, or your community.

How Big?

- No Specific requirement
- Typical is 100-400 hours including planning
- Should be a challenge to the Scout (age specific)
- Must demonstrate Leadership of Others

Project Examples from our District

- Planting trees & shrubs
- Break area tables for charitable organization
- Acquiring and shipping care packages to Iraq schoolchildren
- Meditation garden for church

Project Examples from our District

- Recovering Kneelers at a Church
- Bird Houses for Parks
- Reworking storm damaged campsites at regional park
- Trail Improvements and Additions (NOT maintenance)

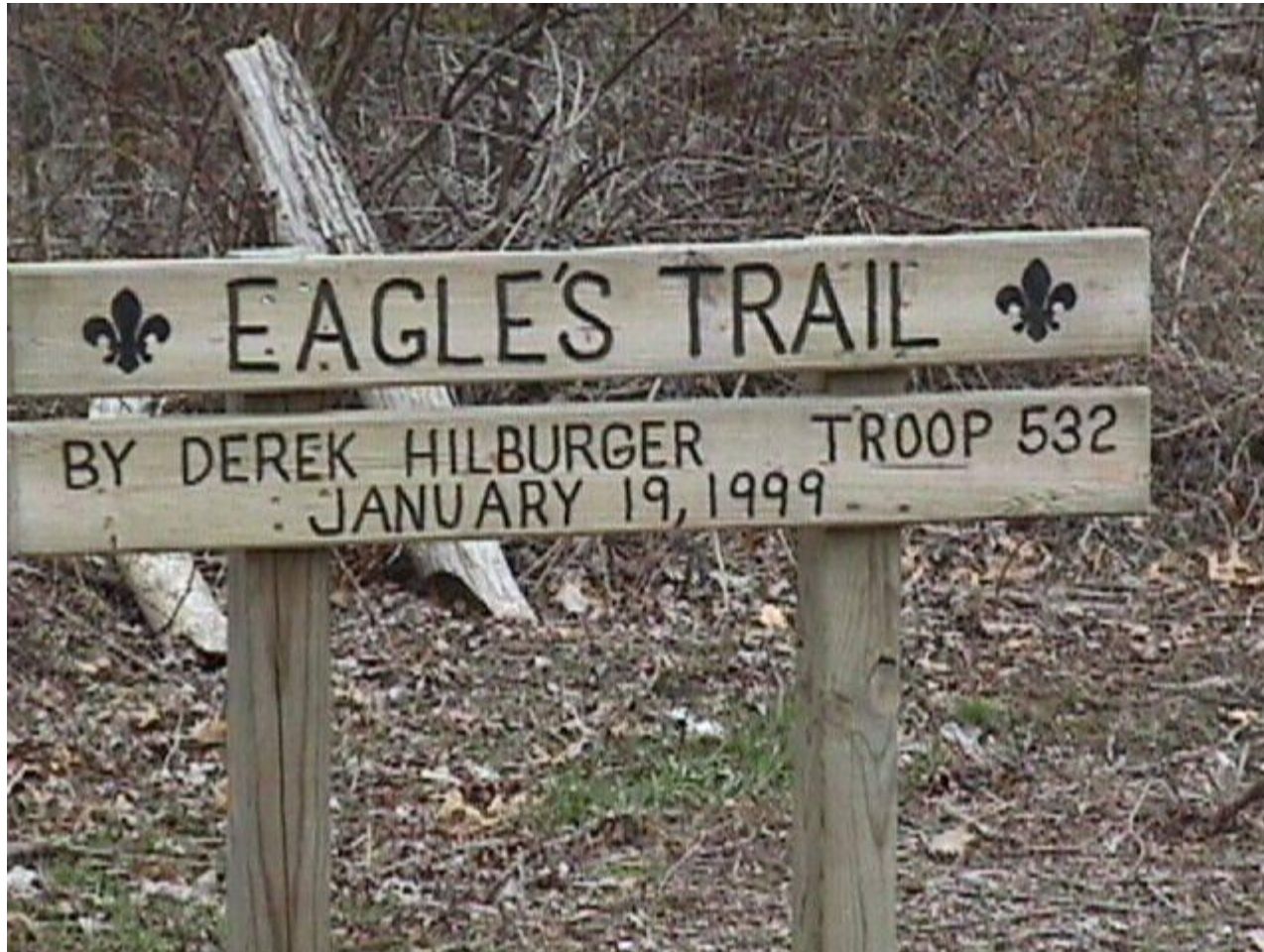

- Who will benefit?
- How will they benefit?
- Who from that group will be providing guidance in planning the project?
- How many people will be recruited to carry out the project?
- What are the costs? How will funds be raised?

The project **IDEA** and **PLAN** must be approved by the:

Sponsoring/benefitting entity

Scoutmaster

Troop Committee

District Advancement Representative
