
Wilderness Remote First Aid Basics

March 4-6, 2011 at the Williamson County Road and Bridge Office, Georgetown

Wilderness Remote First Aid Basics is an American Red Cross (ARC) course for people in backcountry and similar situations where professional emergency care is over 30 minutes away. The course combines classroom lecture, skills practice, and realistic scenarios to teach assessment, basic and advanced first aid techniques, extended care, transports and evacuations. **As a prerequisite, participants must have current First Aid and Adult CPR / AED skills equivalent to what is taught in the ARC Standard First Aid and CPR course (please e-mail a copy of your card to sgyaa.crew911@gmail.com in order to complete registration for this class).** A minimum age of 14 is recommended due to the serious nature of the course and scenarios, however, mature youth are strongly encouraged to attend.

SCHEDULE: Course check-in starts at 6 PM, Friday evening at the Williamson County Road and Bridge Office in Georgetown. Current schedule is Fri. 6:30 PM to 9 PM, Sat. 1:30 PM to 9 PM, and Sun. 9 AM to 4 PM. We will do class room time Friday thru Sunday with scenarios on Sunday.

REGISTRATION: The registration is only via the Crew 911 website form (see the back page). BSA membership is required. Course Fee is \$100 per adult or youth participant. This fee covers meals, books and all course materials. The class roster is filled on a first come, first served basis. Previous classes have filled months in advance, so please register early to avoid disappointment! No registrations will be accepted after 5:00 pm on March 2nd, 2011. There are no cancellation refunds. You are responsible to provide an alternate for your slot with notification via e-mail to the attached contact with the replacement persons' name and required information.

COMPLETION: Those who successfully complete this class (**including showing prior proof of current Adult CPR and AED training**) will receive the ARC "Wilderness and Remote First Aid" card which is valid for 2 years. This card satisfies the Philmont Wilderness First Aid requirement. According to the administrative guide, we now have to verify age of the youth. Proof of age, if under 20 years old, will be determined by a state ID, birth certificate, passport, drivers license, or military ID..

WHAT TO BRING: With this training being on a single, full weekend. Camping will not be available but being present, all days will be required. Bring season and weather appropriate clothing for outside (including rain gear!) as we plan to be outdoors for a large amount of the class. Bring water bottles or a hydration system and a pencil and notepad. Class A uniforms are encouraged but are not required. Scenarios on Sunday will require working on the ground, so plan to wear something that can get dirty!

MEALS: Lunch, dinner, plenty of snacks, and refreshments will be provided. No breakfast will be provided.

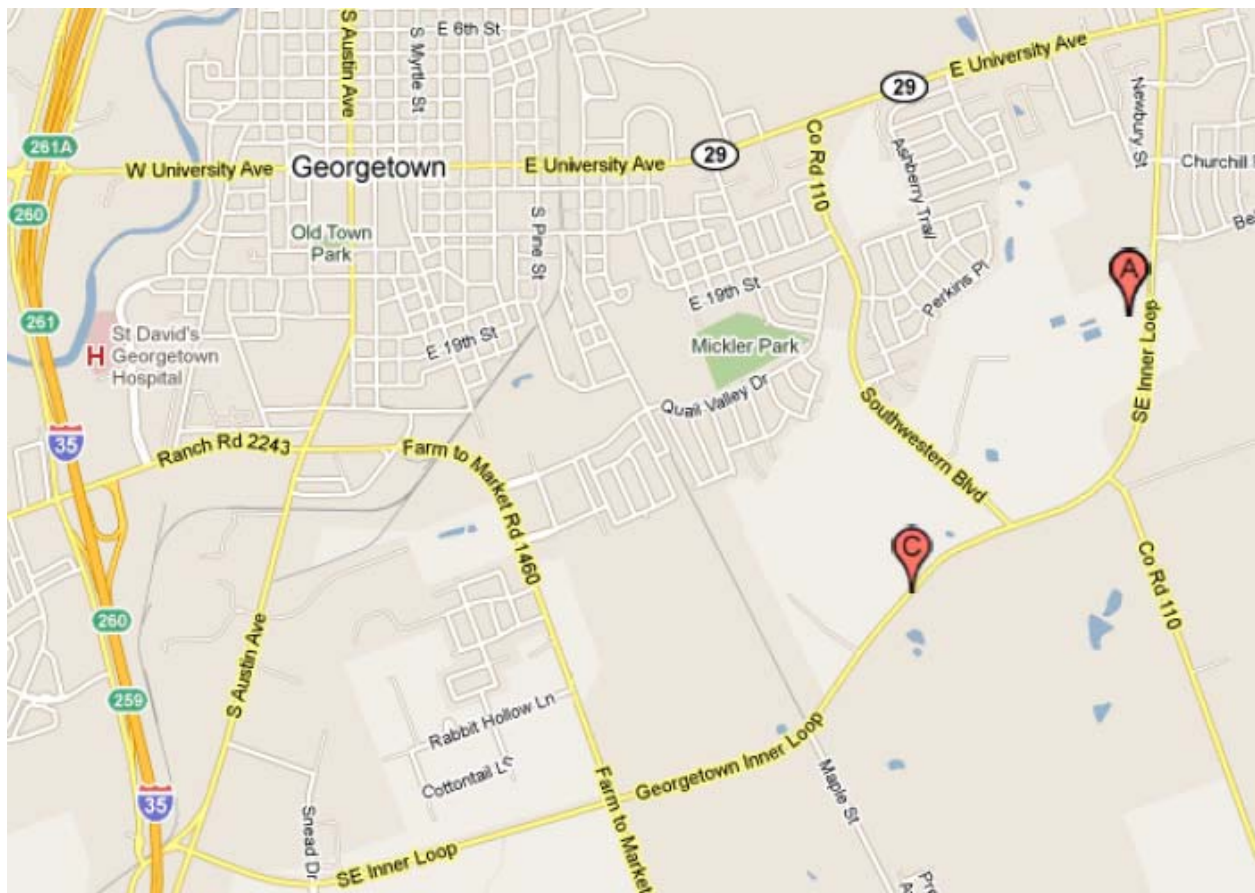
ATTENDING AS A UNIT: We welcome multiple participants from the same unit; many units find it especially effective to bring older youth along with adult leaders. Units bringing youth are responsible for their own two-deep leadership at night and for providing at least one adult leader during classes – if needed our instructors can serve as your second adult during class sessions. Please bring current BSA medical forms for any youths attending.
